Cheesman stated the department as well as other agencies participated in active shooter training at Wainwright Elementary. Responding to Harrison, Cheesman stated that almost all officers will be working the US Open and Pierce County will be compensating for their time. Discussion continued regarding rentals of properties in Fircrest during the US Open and Cheesman, in response to

Jinhong, stated the officers will be diligent during the US Open event to ensure that things remain orderly and confirmed that no permits are required for residents to rent their houses out during the event.
