



Master Gardener Program

Fox Property Site SE Corner of Electron and Contra Costa

- L- Shaped plot layout due to trees and resulting sunshine challenges
- Sunshine Afternoon only. The further south the less hours of sun. Sun available noon and on. (March – Sept)
 - Reminder- root vegetables need min 6 hours/day & fruiting vegetables need min 8 hours/day
- Water Meter from previous house.
- Gardener access Street parking Electron Way and Contra Costa.
- Delivery access Driveway from previous house still in parking strip, but permanent sign on 4x4 blocks access.



Garden Layout Fox Property

- Plot Size (70' x 20') + (20' x 20') Plot size = 1400 ft² +
 400 ft² = 1800 ft² total
 - Layout A 15 beds total, all 3'x16'
 - Layout B 12 beds total, 9 beds 3'x19' and 3 beds 3'x16'
- Possible expansion on the north side to the east, but this will never be a large site due to tall fir trees.
 - Note that Fircrest Park was 5625 ft² and Whittier Park was 4800 ft²




Garden Layout A Fox Property

Water Consumption Business Plan – Fox Property

- 70' x 20' + 20' x 20' Plot size = $1400 \text{ ft}^2 + 400 \text{ ft}^2$
 - $= 1800 \text{ ft}^2$
- 5840 ft³ of water for the growing season
 - 2017 water rate \$275

*Possible reduction if City of Fircrest does not bill during non-growing season. Water is shutoff completely during that time.



Water Distribution Projected Costs

- Hose bibs plus structure (9)
- Underground piping (xx feet)
- Backflow preventer

Optional Fencing Projected Costs

- •Fencing tbd costs.
- May keep existing shrubs and small trees.
- •Tennis court (E) and tot lot (S) sides are fenced.

Raised Beds Projected Costs

 Design for different bed width and lumber dimensions.

- Beds are 20 feet long
- Beds are 3 feet wide or
- Beds are 4 feet wide
- Lumber is 2" x 4" or
- Lumber is 2" x 6" or
- Lumber is 2" x 8"

Assumes cedar lumber.

Does not assume any wasted lumber. Does not include fasteners. If double decking it would require 2" x 2" for structure.



Community Engagement Opportunities

- Educational classes open to residents that are held at the community center. Focus would be on various topics (edible flowers etc) and taught by Master Gardeners
- K-12 educational trips to incorporate healthy and sustainable eating
- Use of locally grown food for healthy cooking classes to be held at community center
