CALL TO ORDER, PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AND ROLL CALL

Mayor Hunter T. George called the special meeting to order at 6:00 P.M. and led the pledge of allegiance. Councilmembers David M. Viafore, Shannon Reynolds, Brett Wittner, Denny Waltier, Blake Surina, and Jamie Nixon were present.

AGENDA MODIFICATIONS

There were none.

YEAR END 2017 FINANCIAL REPORT

Finance Director Corcoran briefed the Council on the financial condition of the City of Fircrest based on the Preliminary Financial reports as of December 31, 2017, including information on:

- Fund Balance by Fund
- General Fund Summary
- Total Ending Fund Balance including Undesignated and Designated Fund Balances
- General Fund Revenue
- Expenditures by Department
- Actual Revenue and Expenditures by Fund
- Available Cash by Fund

Corcoran indicated the ending fund balances for each of the funds increased, and that after accounting for the operating revenues and expenditures, capital, and non-revenue and non-expenditures, the General Fund Ending Fund Balance increased by \$244,839 to \$3,308,755. Corcoran stated the City had a conservative approach as it pertained to revenue estimates and purchasing decisions, indicating the City received 103.7% of anticipated revenue and expensed 92.7% of anticipated operating expenditures (without capital).

There was a brief discussion on the reconvening the Investment Committee and filling the vacancy via appointment. George noted Viafore's recommendation that the Committee should meet quarterly, at minimum, to approve the minutes of the last meeting.

Surina inquired on whether using ending fund balances was possible to fund the pool project and a discussion followed on the benefits and drawbacks of this option. The general concerns were that the tax revenue was not sufficient to replace this capital expense, reserves should be expended on core services and reserved for cost overruns, and drawing upon reserves could negatively impact the City's bond rating, which could impact the financing for the Community Center project. Viafore commented on implementing a graphic to help educate citizens how tax revenues are distributed to the local, county, and other levels of government.

COMMUNITY CENTER AND POOL PROJECT STEERING COMMITTEE

Pingel briefed the Council on an updated draft of charter of the Fircrest Pool and Community Center Steering Committee, which included the proposed purpose and primary functions of the Committee, roles and responsibilities, membership, and meeting schedule and process. George added that the update to the scope addressed the potential inclusion of the backlog of parks projects in the event of a bond issuance. George noted that the Committee would provide expertise and advise the City Council on the project generally. George commented on his experience being on the Metro Parks Tacoma Steering Committee for the Eastside Community Center project, including lessons learned, community engagement, and committee membership. Pingel shared the documents that established the City's Community Center Advisory Committee in 2008, pointing out the purpose, member responsibilities, and job descriptions, which could be of aid in the development of the Steering Committee charter. It was decided that the Steering Committee charter would be included in the March Council study session and for Council approval at the March 27th regular meeting.

George commented that the Senate capital budget proposal included \$750,000 for the Fircrest Pool project and that House capital budget proposal would be released soon. George noted that even if the House budget did not include any funds for the Fircrest Pool project, there was a potential for the funds to be partially or fully included during budget negotiations. George stated that he, Councilmember Waltier, and Pingel would meet with Senator O'Ban and Representatives Kilduff and Muri in Olympia the following day. George thanked staff for their efforts in prepared the capital budget request application.

ADJOURNMENT

Viafore MOVED to adjourn the meeting at 6:57 P.M., seconded by Reynolds. <u>The Motion</u> <u>Carried (7-0)</u>.

PROPOSAL: The Council is being asked to authorize the City Manager to execute a third amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with KPG, P.S. to provide on call engineering services for transportation type projects and additional services as needed. The work elements of this agreement will be authorized by task order.

FISCAL IMPACT: The agreement does not have a contract amount as the work will be authorized by task order for each task. This total cost is to be within the budgeted amount for professional services for this department.

ADVANTAGE: Since KPG has provided the City on call services in 2016, 2017, and 2018 by having an on call engineer that specialize in the area of expertise required by the city, the third amendment to the existing on call agreement allows the City to obtain the services as-needed that are beyond just street and transportation elements. Additional services that KPG is capable of providing are included in the updated scope of work as well as other additional services as needed.

DISADVANTAGES: By not having an on call engineer for services, the City would be required to delay the work for the selection process and also provide a professional services agreement for each task required throughout the year.

ALTERNATIVES: Not to have an on call engineer for services and either not use the budgeted services or prepare a professional services agreement for each task needed.

HISTORY: Previously, the City contracted with KPG for on call engineering services for the year 2016, 2017, and 2018. Since both the City and KPG has had success this last year in those services and KPG is capable of providing additional services not specific to the Exhibit A – Scope of Services, the scope of services has been expanded to include those additional items and additional services as needed by the City and provide by KPG. Exhibit A – Scope of Services has been revised to reflect this. The City and KPG wishes to expand the services and continue this on call contract.

EXHIBIT A

SCOPE OF SERVICES ON-CALL ENGINEERING SERVICES STREET AND TRANSPORTATION

1. General Scope

The consultant shall provide engineering services to the City of Fircrest on an on-call basis. Services required by the City may include, but not limited to the following work items for street and transportation related projects and additional services as needed by the City and provided by the consultant.

- Sidewalk improvement designs
- Street design
- 6 year TIP
- TIB and WSDOT funding requirements
- Transportation Planning
- Street and Sidewalk mapping and GIS
- Street lighting LED conversions
- Traffic counts and intersection assessments
- NPDES permit requirements
- Storm system analysis and improvements
- Utility evaluation and design
- Construction monitoring and management

2. Task Orders

Prior to proceeding with any work, the Consultant and the City shall determine the specific scope of services required. A detailed written scope of work and fee estimate shall be prepared by the consultant for each task order. Task Orders shall be issued on the Task Order form which is attached to Exhibit A, Scope of services and is included as part of the agreement.

3. Authorization to Proceed

The Consultant shall proceed with the work only after receipt of the executed Task Order signed by the Public Works Director and Consultant. Additional work outside of the Task Order scope and estimate shall not be exceeded unless authorized in writing by amending the existing task order or executing a new Task Order.
