**SUBJECT:** 2019 Comprehensive Plan Update

#### Introduction

Chapter 23.06 Comprehensive Plan Amendments establishes the process by which the Fircrest Comprehensive Plan can be updated and amended each year. This year's update will address any state requirements and/or staff revisions as well as updates to the Six-Year Capital Improvement Program.
