

**CITY OF FIRCREST
RESOLUTION NO. 1614**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIRCREST,
WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING NO INCREASE IN THE AMOUNT AND
PERCENTAGE INCREASE OF THE 2020 REGULAR PROPERTY TAX
LEVY OVER THE 2019 REGULAR PROPERTY TAX LEVY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Fircrest attest that the district population is 6,770; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fircrest has properly given notice of the public hearing held October 8, 2019 to consider revenue sources for its budget for the calendar year 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Fircrest's actual levy amount from the previous year was \$1,590,617.80; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Fircrest after hearing and after duly considering all relevant evidence and testimony presented, determined that the City of Fircrest requires a regular property levy increase of 0.0% from the previous year exclusive of additional revenue resulting from new construction, improvements to property, any increase in the value of state assessed property, any annexations that have occurred and refunds made, in order to discharge the expected expenses and obligations of the City of Fircrest and in its best interest. Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIRCREST:


Section 1: That no increase in the regular property tax levy is hereby authorized for the levy to be collected in the 2020 tax year.

Section 2: The dollar amount of the increase over the actual levy amount form the previous year shall be \$0.00 which is a percentage increase of 0.0% from the previous year.

Section 3: This increase is exclusive of additional revenue resulting from new construction, improvements to property, any increase in the value of state assessed property, any annexations that have occurred and refunds made.


