


Gene Goodwin Tot Lot

- 1. Renovated Tennis Courts: overlay paving, sports court coating, nets, fencing, wind screen & drainage
- 2 Restroom / Shelter / Storage Structure: 2 Unisex restrooms / mechanical chase, covered area, picnic tables, drinking fountain, bike rack, litter receptacles, motion detection security lighting
- 3. A four foot ornamental fence will provide a physical barrier to preschoolers and a boundary limit for others.
- 4. Completed 2016 Themed Pre-School Play opportunities
- 5. Synthetic turf play hill with climbing nets
- 6. Park Identification Sign with landscaping
- 7. Themed, artistic, playful site furnishings (not shown)
- 8. Re-Located Entry with Gateway Trellis
- 9. Paved walks with skillful patterns forming numbers, letters, hopscotch, etc. will provide ADA compliant routes to all facilities.
- 10. Picnic Tables with Concrete Pads (not shown)
- 11. Picnic Shelter
- 12. Full Court Basket Ball Court
- 13. Completed 2020: ADA compliant Pre-school swings with ADA compliant surfacing.
- 14. Nature Play Area with a wide variety of logs, boulders, gravel and other natural materials.
- 15. Picnic Shelter with 4 picnic tables & motion detection security lights
- 16. A buffer separation between the sport courts and tot play areas (not shown)
- 17. 90° Parking Stalls added along Electron Way with ADA Accessible stalls
- 18. Benches (not shown)
- 19. Landscaping
- 20. Pickleball Court / Multi Purpose Court






Alice Peers Park

- 4. Landscape and irrigation improvements (not shown)






Masko Park

- 1. Greenscreen or Living Wall around well house
- 2. Park identification sign / landscape
- 3. Resurface trails (not shown)
- 4. Information kiosk with new drinking fountain
- 5. Seabrook Rhodendron Garden restoration, irrigation, interpretive signage
- 6. New concrete stairway to City Hall
- 7. New concrete walkway connection to City Hall
- 8. New Garden Access
- 9. Restoration landscape & irrigation (not shown)






Whittier Park

- 1. New Tennis Courts on higher ground in a quieter setting. Three new Tennis Courts will feature new paving sports coatings, nets, wind screen, drainage and fencing.
- 2. 2018: Landscaping upgrade hedge removed (diseased) replaced with Ornamental Maples
- 3. Parking Lot Renovation: seal coating, signage & striping for one way circulation
- 4. Restroom / Storage / Shelter Structure: 2 Unisex restrooms / mechanical chase, team storage, shelter for (4) 6' picnic tables minimum, motion detection security lighting, drinking fountain
- 5. Existing Shelter: renovate
- 6. Play Plaza: Pre School & School Age themed play opportunities, climbing boulders and climbing net over synthetic turf surfacing, seating, picnic tables, litter receptacles, bike rack, skate area for beginners
- 7. Soccer Fields / Baseball Field: turf renovation: installation of new subsurface drain lines, deep tine aerate, top dress & seed, irrigation repair,
- 3. Sports field lighting renovation: evaluate locations and update technology to efficient standards, minimize light pollution leaving site (not shown)
- 9 Five foot wide (5') perimeter pervious trail
- 10. Wetland Trail with interpretive signage (not shown)
- 11. Park Identification Sign
- 12. Teen / Adult Court activity space
- 13. New Bocce Courts / Horse Shoes
- 14. Six foot (6') High Fence replacement
- 15. Native plant replacement
- 16. Turf Area
- 17. Trail Connection to Leach Creek Area





Thelma Gilmur Park

- 1. Improve street presence / appeal: Park Identification Sign, pedestrian access, entry plaza, welcome / information kiosk, screen transformers, pet waste station, litter receptacle, bike rack
- 2. New trail surfacing, fine grading for existing trails
- 3. New interpretive signage (not shown)
- 4. Invasive plant removal & native plant restoration (not shown)
- 5. New decking & handrails for pond and Friesz overlooks
