WHEREAS, the original Fircrest Community Center and Pool served the community for nearly 60 years; and

WHEREAS, the Fircrest City Council wishes to honor those that built and operated the original Fircrest Community Center and Pool, creating a lasting legacy of recreation programs for the Fircrest community; and

WHEREAS, numerous Fircrest community members engaged in dialogue beginning in 2014 to identify options and then to design and develop a new community center and pool; and

WHEREAS, 79 percent of participating voters approved a park bond, the Washington Legislature approved a pair of substantial grants, and generous families in the community contributed to a fundraising campaign, led by the incredible generosity of the Names and Edwards families; and

WHEREAS, the new Roy H. Murphy Community Center and the Edwards Family Aquatic Center are now complete and ready to serve the community and carry forward Fircrest's recreation legacy; and

WHEREAS, the Fircrest City Council wishes to recognize and honor all who made this project possible and will benefit for years to come.
