**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
FIRCREST, WASHINGTON AMENDING THE PERSONNEL  
POLICIES AND PROCEDURES MANUAL FOR EMPLOYEES  
OF THE CITY OF FIRCREST TO INCLUDE JUNE 19TH, ALSO  
KNOWN AS JUNETEENTH, AS A RECOGNIZED, PAID  
HOLIDAY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Fircrest wishes to recognize June 19th as the date that commemorates the end of slavery in the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, since its origin in 1865 in Galveston, Texas, the observance of June 19th (Juneteenth) as the African American Emancipation Day has spread across the United States and beyond; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to include the Juneteenth Holiday as a recognized, paid holiday at the City of Fircrest, and include it in the Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIRCREST:**

**Section 1.** The Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual, as established by Resolution No. 1637, is hereby amended to add the Juneteenth Holiday as a recognized, paid holiday, as attached hereto.


**Section 2.** This resolution shall become effective April 27, 2022.
