1 CITY OF FIRCREST **RESOLUTION NO. 1766** 2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF 3 FIRCREST, WASHINGTON AMENDING THE PERSONNEL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES MANUAL FOR EMPLOYEES 4 OF THE CITY OF FIRCREST TO INCLUDE JUNE 19TH, ALSO 5 KNOWN AS JUNETEENTH, AS A RECOGNIZED, PAID HOLIDAY. 6 **WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Fircrest wishes to recognize June 19th as the 7 date that commemorates the end of slavery in the United States; and 8 WHEREAS, since its origin in 1865 in Galveston, Texas, the observance of June 19th 9 (Juneteenth) as the African American Emancipation Day has spread across the United States and beyond; and 10 **WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to include the Juneteenth Holiday as a recognized, 11 paid holiday at the City of Fircrest, and include it in the Personnel Policies and 12 Procedures Manual. 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE **CITY OF FIRCREST:** 14 15 Section 1.
