**WHEREAS**, on July 10th, 2022 a public hearing was held on the proposed Program. No comments on the proposed Program were received at the public hearing. The City Council has considered the proposed priority array and determined the priorities of projects identified in the Program appear to be in the best interest of the City and its residents; Now, Therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIRCREST:**

**Section 1.** The 2023-2028 Six-Year Comprehensive Transportation Improvements Program dated July 26th, 2022 is hereby adopted as the Six-Year Comprehensive Transportation Improvement Program for the City of Fircrest from and after January 1, 2022 and until amended by subsequent action of the City Council.

**Section 2.** The City Clerk or designee is hereby authorized and directed to forward copies of the 2023-2028 Comprehensive Transportation Improvement Program to the appropriate State, regional and local agencies and to file the same in the official City records.
