CITY OF FIRCREST ORDINANCE NO. 1686

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FIRCREST, WASHINGTON, AMENDING FIRCREST MUNICIPAL CODE ("FMC") 2.44.050 RELATING TO SALARIES OF NON-UNION CITY EMPLOYEES AND AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 1676; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City adopted Ordinance No. 1676, which reflected a cost of living increase of 6.3% based on the Consumer Price Index All Urban Consumers (CPI-W) for the year ending June 2021;

WHEREAS, the City requires the expertise of a professional IT Systems Coordinator to assist with the day-to-day needs of the critical infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined it is in the public interest to amend FMC 2.44.050.

NOW. THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIRCREST DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. FMC 2.44.050, Amended. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1676 and FMC Section 2.44.050 are hereby amended to read as follows:

<u>Non-Union Salaries</u>. From and after August 30, 2022, the full-time equivalent monthly salary range of the following regular full-time, regular part-time, and temporary City positions is fixed at the following sums. No employee shall be paid an average monthly base salary, which exceeds the maximum provided hereunder.

11	and any references thereto.				
12	Section 4. Severability. If any section, subsection				
13	of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

15	Section 5. Summary, Publication, and Effective Date. This Ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City and				
16	shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after its adoption and publication as required by law.
