**CITY OF FIRCREST
ORDINANCE NO. 1688**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
FIRCREST, WASHINGTON AMENDING SECTION 1 OF
ORDINANCE NO. 1628 AND FMC 3.20.360 TO
ACCOMMODATE AN ADDITIONAL \$125 REVOLVING CASH
FUND FOR THE PARKS/RECREATION DIRECTOR;
PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, petty cash funds were established by the City Council in 1987 and there is a need to change the amounts authorized for revolving cash funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIRCREST, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1628 and FMC 3.20.360 are hereby amended to read as follows:

3.20.360 Petty Cash funds.

(a) There are created and established change funds as follows:

<u>Custodian</u>	<u>Amount</u>
Finance Director	\$125.00
Court Administrator	\$200.00
Parks/Recreation Director	\$ 90.00

(b) There are created and established revolving cash funds as follows:

<u>Custodian</u>	<u>Amount</u>
Police Chief	\$ 50.00
Finance Director	\$410.00
Parks/Recreation Director	\$125.00

(c) Each change fund and revolving cash fund will be maintained and monitored in accordance with methods prescribed by the State Auditor's Office.

Section 2. Corrections. The City Clerk and codifiers of the ordinance are authorized to make necessary corrections to this ordinance including, but not limited to, the correction of scrivener/clerical errors, references, ordinance numbering, section/subsection numbers, and any references thereto.




