RESOLUTION NO. 1943**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
FIRCREST, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING THE MIDDLE
HOUSING AD HOC CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Fircrest desires to create a Special Ad Hoc Citizen Advisory Committee per the Fircrest City Council Rules of Procedure, Section 23.c. to be designated as the Middle Housing Committee (“Committee”); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Committee will be to advise the City Council and assist with gathering and preparing materials and supporting documentation for an application to the Washington State Department of Commerce for City Council consideration for an alternative to or timeline extension for full implementation of the provisions of [House Bill 1110](#) regarding Middle Housing, passed by the Washington State Legislature in 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City Council Rules of Procedure Section 23.C.3. states that Special Ad Hoc Citizen Advisory Committees shall sunset at the end of each calendar year unless specifically continued by the Council thereafter for a specific time period; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires that the Middle Housing Ad Hoc Citizen Advisory Committee remain an active Special Ad Hoc Citizen Advisory Committee until the extension application materials are completed for consideration by the City Council or by June 30, 2025, whichever comes first.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF FIRCREST:**




