# WHITTIER REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Whittier is one of 8 school replacements or renovations funded by the \$535 million school construction bond voters passed in 2020.

## **Current Whittier Elementary**

- Built in 1962
- Sits at 32,881 sq ft.
- 311 current student enrollment
- Serves PreK-3 students

### **New Whittier Elementary**

- Anticipated 40,000 sq. ft.
- Up to 400 projected student enrollment
- Remains PreK-3
- Opens fall 2027



# WHITTIER REPLACEMENT PROJECT TIMELINE

The existing Whittier building will be demolished with construction of the new school from 2026 to 2027. Whittier staff and students will use the Eastside swing school-former historic McKinley Elementary School-for the next two school years, as their new school is built.





### Sept 2027

New Whittier opens to students.

## **TRANSITION PLAN**

An alternative plan to keep students on-site was presented to the public last spring, but it was ultimately not supported.


While Whittier is under construction, students will attend school at the Eastside swing site for two years from 2025-27.

#### **Transitions & Adjustments**

- Whittier staff move out/in: June-Aug 2025
- 1st day of school: Students attend Eastside school in the fall, Sept. 2025.
- **Transportation:** Students living in the current Whittier boundary will receive transportation.
- **Before/After school programs:** any programs provided by the school will remain in effect.







# **ABOUT EASTSIDE**

McKinley Elementary School, a designated historic site in Tacoma, closed in 2011. Today, it serves as a temporary school for students and staff during school renovations or replacements.

• HVAC: new heating, ventilation & air-conditioning system • Lighting: new LED lighting in classrooms/common areas
