Preparing with the City of Fircrest

In preparation for construction, the team has been working closely with the City of Fircrest to review permitting requirements and address potential project challenges early. This proactive coordination helps ensure the process moves smoothly once formal permit steps begin. By identifying solutions ahead of time, the project team is keeping the project on track and building strong partnerships that will support the work in the years ahead.

Looking Ahead

Construction of the new Whittier Elementary is scheduled to begin in May/June 2026, with construction taking place between 2025 and 2027. Students and staff will remain on campus during the project, continuing to learn and grow while their new school is built.

At an open house in the fall, the project team will share design progress, gather community input, and answer questions. More details will be shared soon.
