Scope of Work

- Conduct a cultural resources survey, including up to 50 shovel probes
- Complete one Historic Property Inventory for Fircrest Park
- Prepare required reporting to meet RCO, State, and Federal standards

Desired Qualifications

- Principal investigator and senior archaeologists meeting Secretary of the Interior professional qualification standards
- Demonstrated expertise in Washington prehistoric and historic archaeology
- Experience working under Executive Order 21-02 and applicable state and local preservation and human remains laws
- Positive working relationships with federally recognized Tribes and experience with tribal coordination
- Experience balancing project goals with cultural resource protection needs
- Proven record of completing work on schedule and within budget

Project Considerations & Assumptions

- All properties within the Area of Potential Effect must be evaluated using appropriate DAHP forms, including eligibility determinations
- A new cultural resources survey is required, including updates to the 2011 Historic Property Inventory forms for the park and pool; the team must include an architectural historian
- Final reports must be submitted to RCO following consultation processes
- All work must meet DAHP reporting standards to ensure protection of cultural and historic site integrity
