RESOLUTION NO. 2006**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FIRCREST, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A FUEL TAX GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE WASHINGTON STATE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT BOARD FOR THE REGENTS WEST OVERLAY (ALAMEDA AVENUE TO 67<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE WEST) PROJECT.**

**WHEREAS**, the Washington State Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) has awarded the City of Fircrest a Fuel Tax Grant to support pavement preservation and roadway improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, the Regents Boulevard corridor between Alameda Avenue and 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue West is a critical arterial experiencing pavement deterioration and is in need of resurfacing to maintain safety, mobility, and long-term pavement performance; and

**WHEREAS**, TIB has approved funding for 68% of eligible project costs, up to a maximum grant award of \$698,607; and

**WHEREAS**, acceptance of this grant requires execution of the Fuel Tax Grant Agreement between the City of Fircrest and the Washington State Transportation Improvement Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that acceptance of the grant and authorization of the agreement are in the best interest of the City and will advance this important roadway preservation project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF FIRCREST:**

**Section 1.** The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Fuel Tax Grant Agreement with the Washington State Transportation Improvement Board for the Regents West Overlay from Alameda Avenue to 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue Project in the amount of \$698,607, and to execute any related documents necessary to implement the terms of the agreement.
